The Right LOCATION

Stewart International Airport – with its easy access to the four East Coast states of New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, and Pennsylvania – is the right location for the world's tourists, business travelers, and other visitors.

Situated in the heart of the Hudson Valley in Orange County, New York, Stewart International is just 60 miles north of New York City. Its comfortable size, modern amenities, and easy access to roads and public transportation make it the gateway to the Hudson Valley and an ideal alternative to the big airports of the region.

The Right PLACE TO VISIT

Recreational activities and sightseeing take center stage in the wide-open spaces of the Hudson Valley. Exciting and diverse places to visit near and around Stewart International Airport include:

- Woodbury Commons Premier Outlets, which offer shopping and travel/tourism packages and is just
 15 minutes away from Stewart International
- wineries, a renowned sculpture garden, scenic drives, and nature walks

- seasonal outdoor sports and activities, including tennis, golf, swimming, ice skating, and skiing
- mansions, museums, performing arts centers, and special events
- picturesque towns with unique shops selling antique furniture, paintings, prints, pottery, sculpture, and photography
- day spas that provide a way for visitors to relax and rejuvenate
- U.S. Military Academy at West Point
- a host of shopping malls with major retailers such as Lord & Taylor, Neiman Marcus, and Pottery Barn
- historic homes, such as those of President George
 Washington and several literary authors
- air shows featuring historic airplanes.

The Right FACILITY

Stewart International Airport combines the sophistication of a large regional airport with the easy-to-navigate appeal of a smaller airport. Completely redesigned in 1998 and expanded in 2007, the lobby accommodates 38 check-in

stations, three new EDS baggage screening systems, a wider entranceway, spacious baggage claim and seating areas, and an ATM. The concourse features seven jet-boarding bridges, ticket counters, spacious gate areas, concessions, and car rental agencies. High-speed broadband wireless connectivity via Wi-Fi service is available throughout the terminal.

Five passenger airlines currently operate out of Stewart International: AirTran Airways, Delta Connection, JetBlue Airways, Northwest Airlines, and US Airways Express.

The Port Authority has committed \$500 million in capital improvements that will boost the airport's capacity, as well as make Stewart International the world's first carbon-negative airport.

The Right LODGING AND TRANSPORTATION

Visitors to the Hudson Valley can stay at nearby hotels within the major chains of Hilton, Best Western, Marriott, Holiday Inn, and Homewood Suites or can stay at quaint inns located throughout the region.

Stewart International Airport offers convenient overnight short- and long-term parking, with easy access to major highways. Public transportation systems serving Stewart International include:

- MetroNorth-Port Jervis line direct to Hoboken, New Jersey, from the Salisbury Mills station
- MetroNorth-Hudson line direct link to Grand Central Station in New York City from the Beacon station
- Amtrak from Poughkeepsie and Croton-Harmon
- Newburgh-Beacon-Stewart link served by the Leprechaun Bus Line
- Shortline Bus to and from the Newburgh Terminal
- Free shuttle service to and from the airport's terminal offered by some area hotels.
